

Since our last update in October, the ECHO team and its partners have focussed on bringing about the 'connectivity' of ARCs to Police control systems.

Here is an update of ECHO's progress:



ECHO officially launched its service offering at an event at the Informa building in London on 13th November. A well-attended event demonstrating how close we are to going live!

Two more ECHO information events are planned for 18th March (Preston) and 19th March (Midlands) providing an opportunity to speak to the ECHO team and key partners.

We are well underway with the ARC onboarding / billing process, which will be through an electronic portal to keep it simple. Details on this will be sent out shortly, with applications expected in February.

We plan to promote ARCs that connect to the service by offering them a purpose designed 'connected' logo as well as listing on our web site.

We have provided a copy of our specification to all the ARC software providers, who are at different stages of their interface development, so please get in touch with yours to see where they are up to and when they think they will be ready to connect to ECHO. There is also good engagement with Police force software providers for their control systems.

We are working hard to complete the necessary paperwork and processes to provide approved ARCs with the necessary 'tools' to get connected ready for 1st April!
